

First aid recommendation if used improperly

1 Recommendations in the event of improper use/accident (depending on the nature of the cause)

MANTZ household air fresheners are always tested by accredited laboratories in accordance with applicable legal, governmental and customer-related requirements. Most of them are exempt from labelling requirements, meaning they pose only a minor health risk.

The recommended First Aid measures are similar for all of our product groups with the various fragrances, or are the same within the product groups. Therefore, the following general recommendations can be made (depending on the nature of the cause):

General instructions:	Consult a physician in the event of persistent symptoms.
After inhalation:	Seek out a fresh air supply. Consult a physician in the event of persistent symptoms.
After skin contact:	Wash immediately with soap and water, then rinse thoroughly. Consult a physician in the event of persistent skin irritation.
After eye contact:	First, remove contact lenses if possible. Rinse out the eye(s) under running water with open eyelids for several minutes. Consult a physician in the event of persistent symptoms.
After swallowing:	Rinse out the mouth and drink a maximum of two normal drinking glasses of water. Do not induce vomiting. If necessary, seek medical treatment from a physician.
Additional instructions:	Symptoms should generally subside after a while. If no improvement occurs, by all means consult a physician.

Example:

Someone handles a liquid air freshener and accidentally rubs it in their eyes, causing a burning sensation in the eyes. ==> Recommendation: First, remove contact lenses if possible. Rinse out the eye(s) under running water with open eyelids for several minutes. Consult a physician in the event of persistent symptoms.
